The former chairman of the CEN technical committee for roofing slates he is also the advisor to the UK governments' building conservation organisations. During the last 18 years he has researched the many variations of traditional UK slating and supported the regeneration of stone-slate quarrying for traditional roofs.

PV-Installations on flat roofs are an increasing additional use of roofs that give additional effects on roof membranes and insulation. The different systems are presented together with questions of angle of incidence, wind effects occurring and ballast requirements found in wind tunnel research. Usability problems may occur on roof membranes tending to ballooning under suction load as well as on slippery roof membranes. An early collaboration between roofer and solar provider is of great advantage and may save time, money and risk.
